# Mission

The Kinzua Youth Development Center (KYDC) home of the Kinzua Wrestling Club (KWC) exists to establish, maintain, and operate programs, facilities, and other services that foster personal and social responsibility in a positive youth development setting for children, adolescents, and young adults at no cost to participants.

## Program Activities

### Beginner/Novice Wrestling Camp

This KYDC/YMCA wrestling camp focused on early tactical-technical wrestling development through the exploration of locomotor activities, wrestling games, and basic maneuvers.



### GLOW (Girls Leading Others Wisely)

Program that promotes teamwork, confidence, and leadership through meaningful, age-appropriate conversations, inspiring discussions, nutrition, and a creative physical activity.



### Seed to Feed (youth gardening program)

Gardening adventure where kids learned to grow their own delicious vegetables from start to finish.



### Pickleball Camp

Introduction to pickleball with instruction focusing on the fundamentals of the sport while emphasizing skill development and fun!



### Sport Development Camp

Children developed the basic locomotor skills needed to become an athlete or at least a "competent mover" in life.



### Family Movie Nights

Bringing the community together for cozy, all-ages evenings of free pizza, popcorn, a coffee bar, and a featured film.



### Beginner Friendly Yoga – for all ages



### Creative Wellness Art Therapy Group

Strategies and techniques taught to support improved wellness through artmaking and creative expression.



### Etiquette Class

A fun, interactive program teaching essential social skills such as table manners, respectful communication, and gracious behavior.






